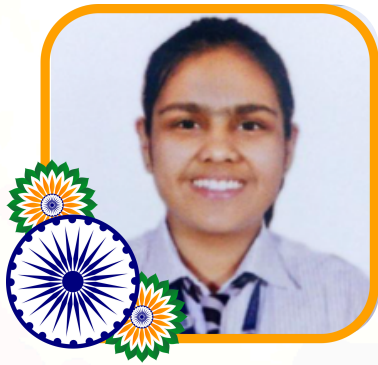


THE TREE

 Tides won't make it a blunder!

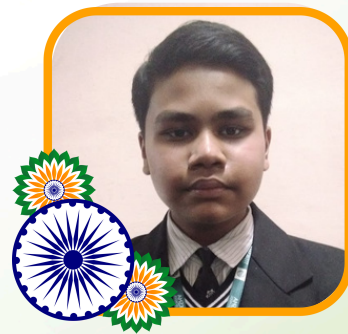

 दिल में बसाए है रखना ॥



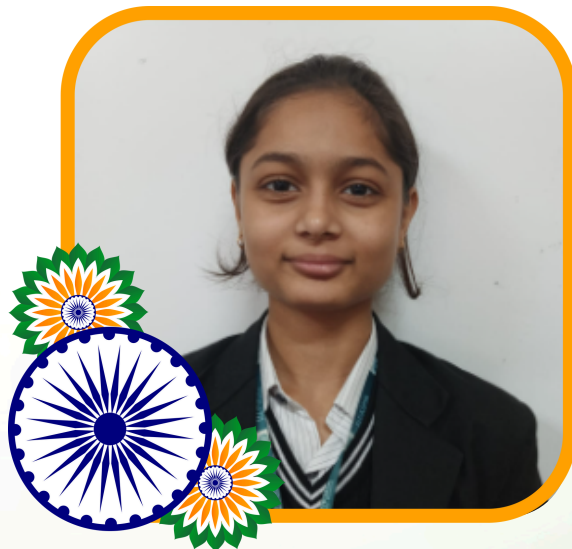

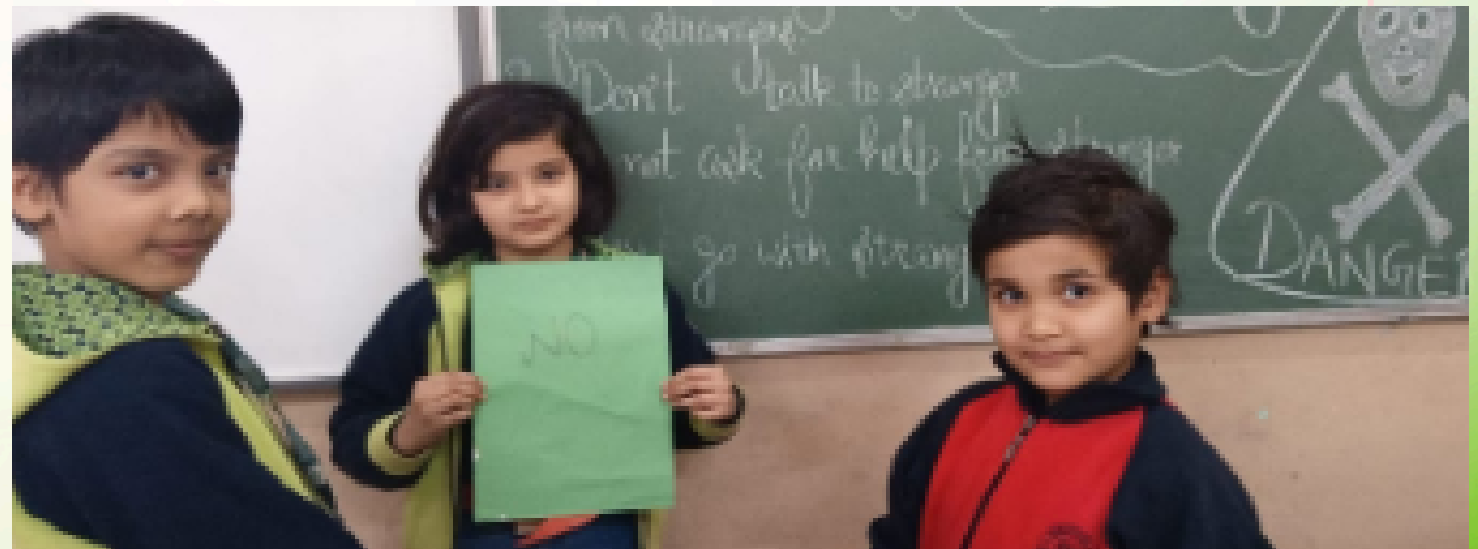
GLIMPSE OF CULTURAL FERVOUR
